Idea

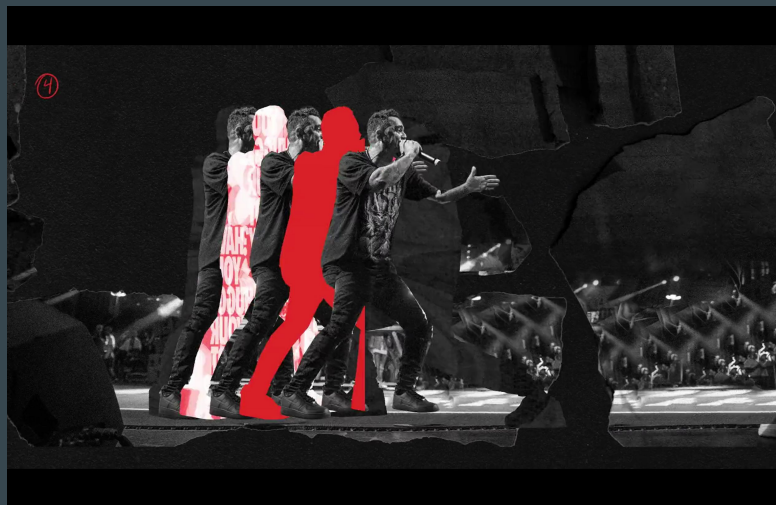

Idea

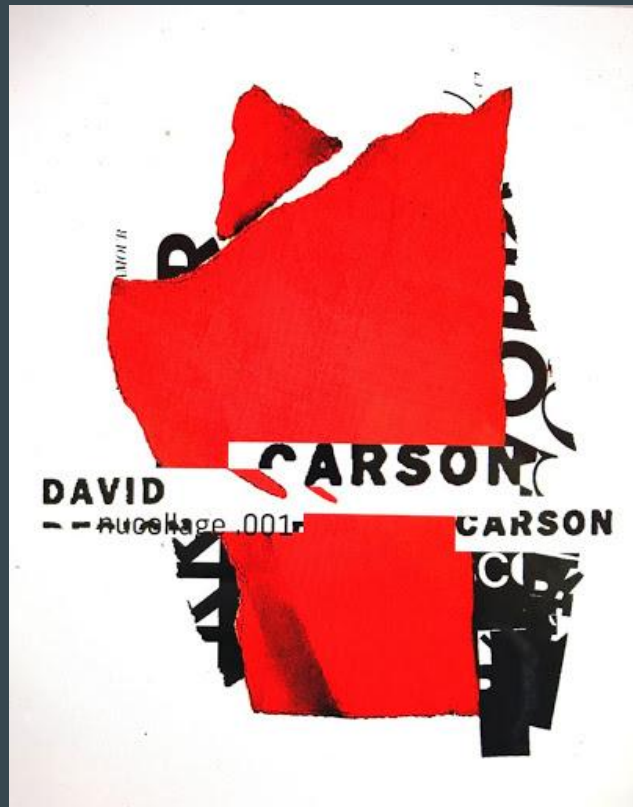

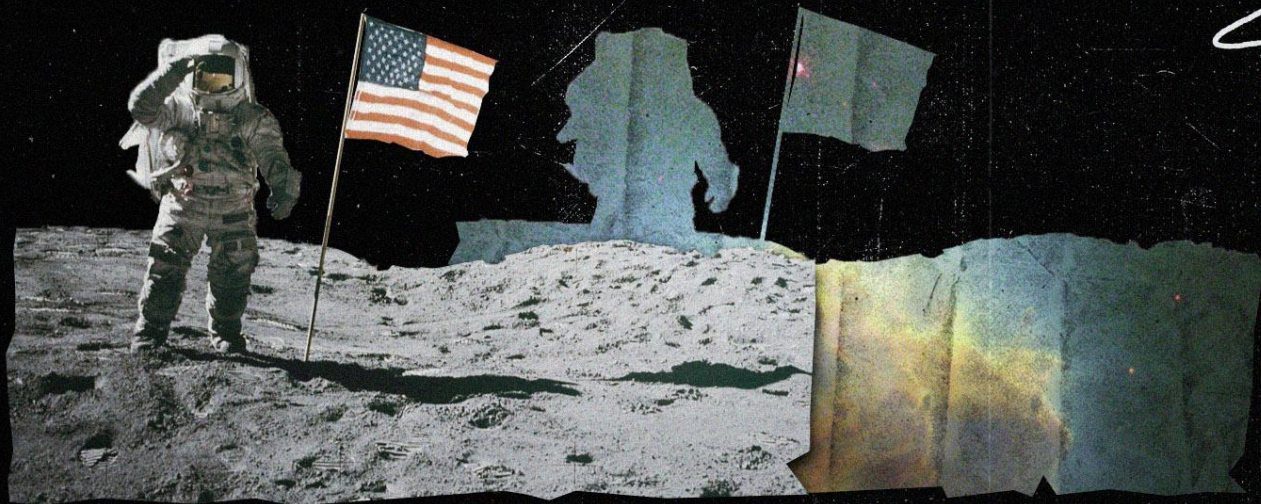
THE WEATHER
